



Birthday Blooms

This card as part of the Stampin' Blends class will show you how easily you can feel like an accomplished artist while using the Stampin' Blends. This project will help you bring the techniques you have learned on the previous to make this beautifully shaded and blended flower. Don't forget to use your Stampin' Blends to color the rhinestones.

For this flower, you will want to work in sections so as to easily blend the light and dark Stampin' Blends together. Remember to use the flicking technique with the darker Stampin' Blend on the pre-shaded or lined areas of the flowers and leaves. Blend the colors together with the circular motion using the nib end of the Stampin' Blend.

1. With Old Olive cardstock measuring 5 ½" x 8 ½", score & fold at 4 ¼" for your cardbase.
2. Stamp flower image and greeting in Momento Black ink on Whisper White cardstock measuring 3 ¾" x 5".
3. Color flower and leaves with Daffodil Delight and Old Olive Stampin' Blends.
4. Adhere Washi tape as shown.
5. Adhere to Basic Black cardstock measuring 3 7/8" x 5 1/8". Adhere to cardbase.
6. Color rhinestones with Dark Daffodil Delight Stampin' Blend and adhere to card.
7. Adhere Black Baker's Twine bow to card.
